What are the ways that can be used to create and manage ecologically sensitive landscapes? Can we help to blur the boundaries between man-made and natural landscapes? How can current and future-ready technologies and alternative passive measures help to create resilience and self-regulation in ecological systems?

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

- a. Please send abstracts of 400 words in length to isolaconference@gmail.com
- b. Abstracts should clearly mention the SUB THEME Category and Keywords
- c. Heading should include the title, author's name, email address, and details on academic/institutional/freelance background.
- d. Please add "ISOLA CALL FOR ABSTRACTS" in the subject line of the mail.
- e. Proposals must be submitted electronically and should be presented either in MS Word or PDF format only.
- f. An individual is allowed to submit only one Abstract.
- g. In case of multiple authors submitting an abstract, details of all authors, as specified above will need to be mentioned.

PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- a. The Paper should be original and should not have been published before in any format.
- b. The format and detailed guidelines for submission of the Final paper shall be intimated upon selection of Abstracts. The Paper has to be submitted in the required format only.
- c. All Papers submitted shall be subjected to a process of blind peer review.
- d. All authors (at least one author in case of Co-Authored papers) will need to register for the conference before submitting the full Paper to ensure inclusion in the programme /publication.
- e. Selected papers will be uploaded on the ISOLA website and will also be included in the post-conference publication. It is also the intention of ISOLA to have the authors present some of the selected papers during the conference.
- f. The authors will be expected to sign a Grant of Rights Form to ISOLA ONLY for referring or publishing proceeds of Conference. A Paper submitted will remain the proprietary of the Author/Authors.
