ISOLA 8th National Conference : The Place of Nature in Tomorrow's City

The Conference was held on 31st August and 01st September 2012 at the Noor-Us-Sabah Palace, Bhopal. In order to explore new territories and expand the profession to hitherto un-explored areas, the conference was for the first time held in Central India in Madhya Pradesh, and there was overwhelming attendance by landscape architects, related professionals, architects, students and stake holders. The EC took upon itself the task of organizing the conference with the local support of the Department of Architecture, Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology and School of Planning and Architecture, Bhopal. The theme this year "THE PLACE OF NATURE IN TOMORROW'S CITY" sought to address the value of natural elements in urban and rural environments, and the economic, social and environmental benefits they provide. The conference aimed to focus on the issues and processes of integrating the natural environment into healthy sustainable urban centres from cultural, socio-political, and planning perspectives with examples from our past and present.

The Chief Guest was Sh. Jayant Mallaiya, Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources and Environment, Government of MP, who also gave away the 2nd Annual ISOLA Awards. The keynote address was delivered by Prof. Neelkanth Chhaya, eminent academician and architect. Speakers this year were drawn from diverse fields to make the conference varied in content and bring about sharing of view points. Prof. James L. Wescoat, Ar. Narendra Dengle, Ar. Yatin Pandya, Mr. Farhad Contractor, Dr. Vikram Soni, Ar. Romi Khosla, Dr. Bimal Patel, Dr. Mahesh Buch presented their views in various sessions. Another interesting feature of the conference was the presentations by participants from various cities presenting their cities focusing on the theme area. This session titled the Indian Panorama, was applauded by the audience owing to the interactive nature of this session. In the evening, after the sessions, there was a performance of the Amritashya Narmada Ballet by the troupe of Dr. Suchitra Harmalkar at the auditorium of the magnificent Bharat Bhawan. On 2nd of September, there was a tour to the world heritage sites of Sanchi and Bhimbetka. Overall, the conference was very well attended and was a huge success.

The 9th Annual conference is proposed to be held in Delhi for the year 2014 in the month of Feb or March.
