The Jury is pleased to receive the nomination of SHRI KISHORE PRADHAN and is unanimous in awarding the ISOLA GOLD MEDAL to him.

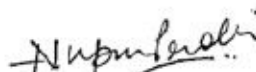

Kishore Pradhan



Kishore Pradhan is a senior Landscape Architect, his practice based out of Mumbai since 1972. At a very young age nature cast a hypnotic spell on him, be it in reality, art or literature and drew him towards the outdoors. Pradhan pursued architecture at Sir. J.J. College of Architecture, Mumbai. After graduation, he acquired proficiency in French language and was awarded a scholarship from the French Government for higher studies. He chose 'Landscape Architecture' as the subject of specialization and soon found himself in Versailles, enrolled in Ecole Nationale Supérieure d'Horticulture, in the Section du Paysage. During his sojourn in France, French culture and philosophy inspired him greatly.

On his return to India in the year 1972, he founded his firm Kishore D. Pradhan, Architectural and Landscape Consultant. His very first landscape design project being the Fort Aguada Beach Resort, Goa for Taj Group of Hotels. Pradhan is on the advisory board of various committees and institutes.

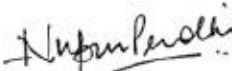

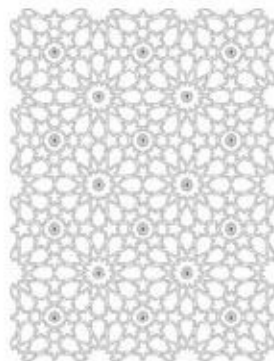

Concept

The Colonial style of architecture brings to mind stately, symmetrical homes with arcades anchoring the entry. Clipped boxwood hedges, topiary, and stone are the traditional elements in Colonial landscape design, that set an impressive scene in large estates. But in this residential project, the landscape design tries to create more a softer & personalized approach to give the landscape a blend of traditional as well as modern landscape design ideas.

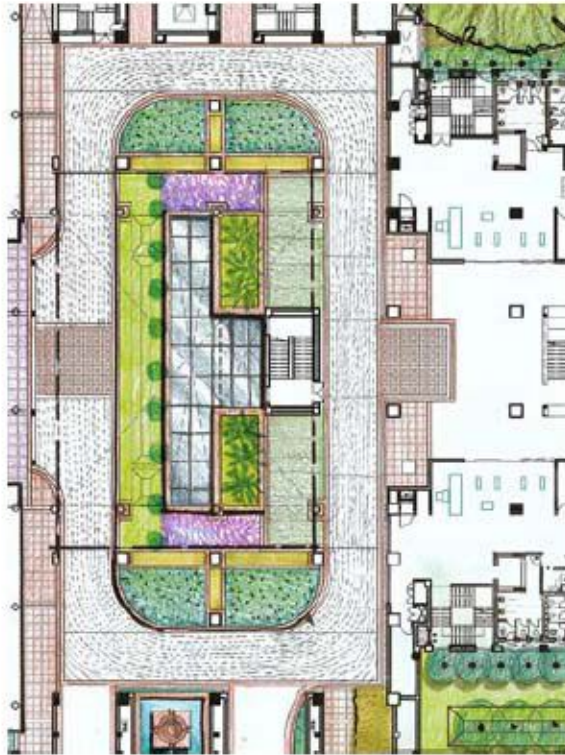

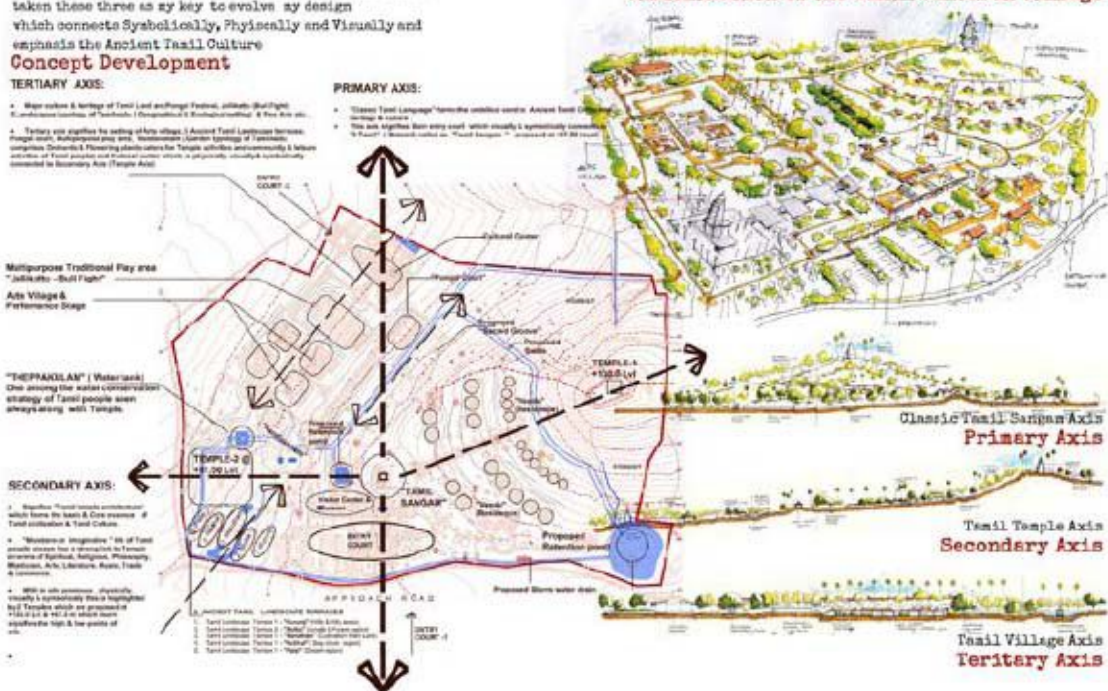

Visualisation of the Tamil Cultural village

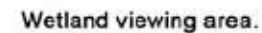
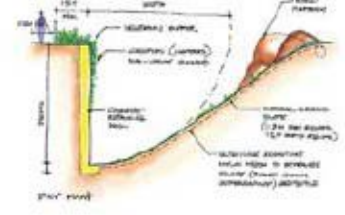


Area detail of Primary axis Tamil Sangam

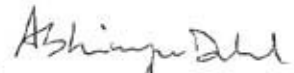
